

## Africa Infrastructure Fund I K/S Exclusion List

- 1. Employ forced labour of any kind;
- 2. Allow children to form part of their workforce;
- 3. Pay wages which are below industry or national minima;
- 4. Are in a country or involve a person, group or entity subject to international trade embargoes or sanctions<sup>1</sup> at the time of investment;
- 5. Generate over 90% of revenue from mining of coal or from energy production based on coal;
- 6. Are incorporated in EU non-cooperative jurisdictions for tax purposes (blacklist) at the time of investment;
- 7. Contain activities or materials deemed illegal under host country laws or regulations or international conventions and agreements, or subject to international phase-outs our bans, such as:
- 8. Ozone depleting substances, PCB's (Polychlorinated Biphenyls) and other, specific, hazardous pharmaceuticals, pesticides/herbicides or chemicals;
- 9. Wildlife or products regulated under the Convention on International Trade in Engendered Species or Wild Fauna and Flora (CITES); or
- 10. Unsustainable fishing methods (e.g., blast fishing and drift net fishing in the marine environment using nets more than 2.5 km in length).
- 11. Include cross-border trade in waste and waste products, unless compliant with the Basel Convention and underlining regulations;
- 12. Involved the destruction of HCV areas:
- 13. Manufacture or trade weapons, including the development, production or storage of nuclear weapons and the production of components made explicitly for use in nuclear weapons;
- 14. Generate power from a nuclear reactor;
- 15. Manufacture tobacco or tobacco-related products, unbonded asbestos fibres or radioactive materials;
- 16. Involve gambling, casinos, and related activities;
- 17. Relate to prostitution or pornography;
- 18. Include racist and/or anti-democratic media; or
- 19. Involve alcoholic beverages (except beer and wine).
